## Trooper Beat

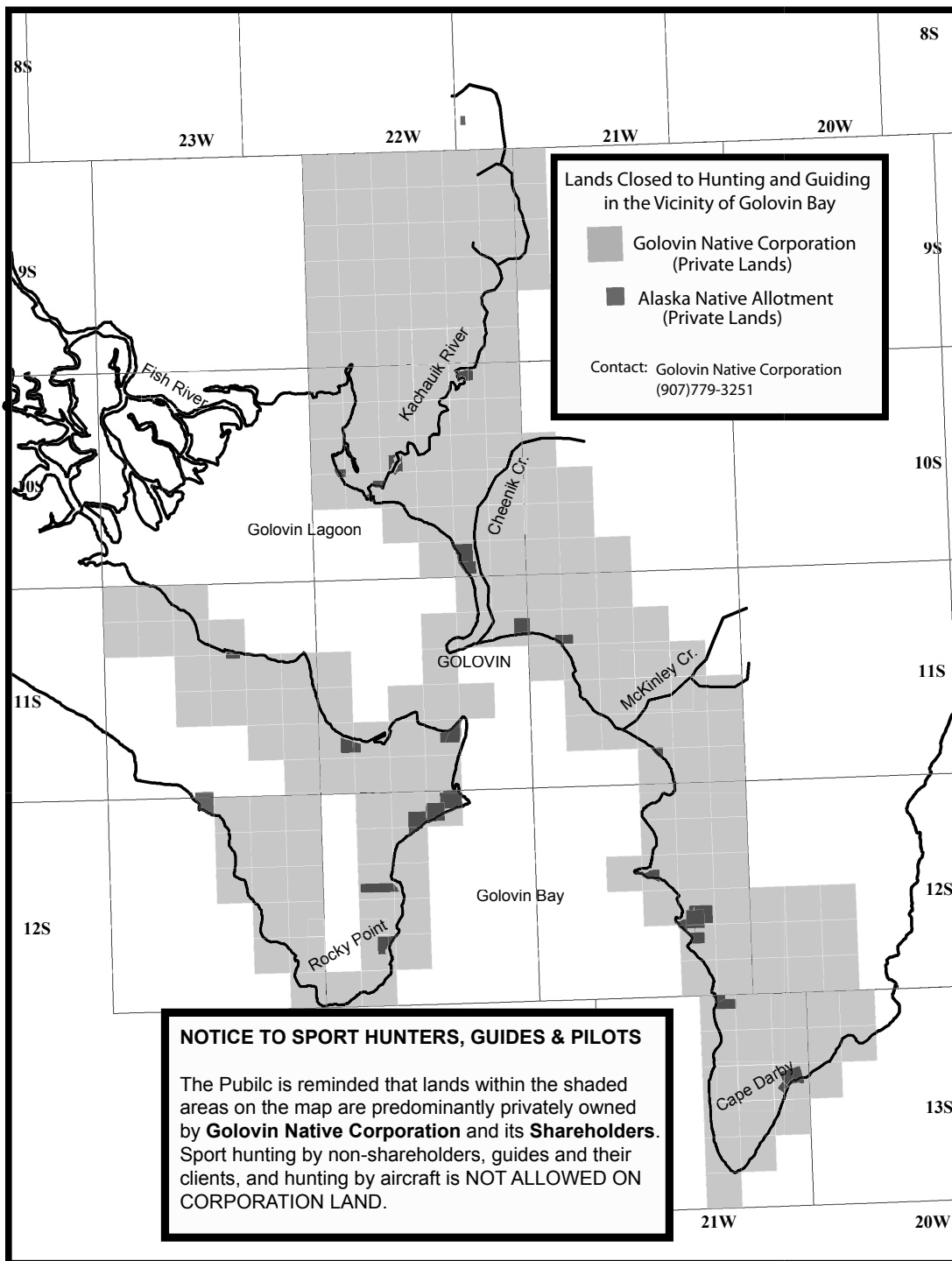
