Assault - DV: On 7/25/23 at approximately 03:54 a.m., Alaska State Troopers received a report of an Assault -DV. Investigation resulted in the arrest of Aloysious Otten, 53, of St. Michael for Assault 4.

**Norton Sound Region**

Sexual Abuse of a Minor: On 7/26/2023 at approximately 6:27 p.m., AST received a report of a Sexual Abuse of a Minor. The investigation is ongoing.

**Bering Sea / Píkmiktalik River**

Search and Rescue, DUI, Assault: On August 3, at 6:11 p.m., the AST were notified that 37-year-old Mountain Village resident Carlie Alexie went overboard from a boat into the Bering Sea near the Píkmiktalik River. A preliminary investigation revealed that 37-year-old Kotlik resident Warren Okitkun, 25-year-old Kotlik resident Caitlyn Prince, Alexie, and a juvenile were boating in the area, and for unknown reasons, Alexie jumped off the boat into the Bering Sea and did not surface. Village Police Officers from Stebbins responded to the area to search for Alexie, and after they arrived, the boat being operated by Okitkun and Prince drove away toward St Michael. The VPOs suspected that both adults were under the influence of alcohol and pursued the boat due to the risk posed to the juvenile still on board. VPOs were able to locate Okitkun and Prince in St Michael. In coordination with the AST, Okitkun and Prince were arrested for Assault and DUI. Efforts to locate Alexie have been unsuccessful at this time. Search efforts have been suspended by local search and rescue groups and the US Coast Guard due to poor weather in the area. Next of kin have been notified.

**Gambell**  
 Attempted Murder: On July 27, at 9:50 pm, AST received a report of a shooting in Gambell, which was originally reported as an attempted suicide. It was later revealed that a 16-year-old minor intentionally shot his uncle Dustin Iworriagan, age 33. Upon shooting Iworriagan, the minor attempted to commit suicide by shooting himself in the abdomen and then went to seek medical aid but did not mention Iworriagan who was found several hours later unconscious. Both the minor and Iworriagan were life flighted to an Anchorage area hospital. Iworriagan received life threatening injuries. The AST Western Major Crimes Unit traveled to Gambell to conduct the investigation. On August 3, the minor was discharged from the hospital and placed under arrest. He is being charged as an adult with Attempted Murder in the First Degree and was booked into McLaughlin Youth Center. Additional charges may be forthcoming. The investigation is ongoing.  
 UPDATE: On August 4, at 10:50 am, AST were notified that Dustin Iworriagan had died as a result of his injury. Charges of Murder in the First Degree will be upgraded against the minor.

tower and the department scheduled one 24-hour commercial period to gauge coho run strength in the marine waters of Subdistrict 3 at 6:00 p.m. Monday, August 7. There are currently no restrictions

on subsistence fishing in the Elim Subdistrict.

### Norton Bay Subdistrict

Norton Bay will open to commercial fishing this week to gauge the strength of the coho salmon run at 6:00 p.m. Monday, August 7, for one 24-hour commercial period. There are currently no restrictions on sub-

sistence fishing in the Norton Bay Subdistrict.

### Shaktoolik and Unalakleet Subdistricts

The Shaktoolik and Unalakleet Subdistricts opened to commercial fishing for one 24-hour period at 6:00 p.m. Monday, August 7 to gauge the strength of coho runs in those subdistricts.

The Shaktoolik and Unalakleet Subdistricts reopened to subsistence fishing in the marine and fresh waters to provide an opportunity for subsistence fishermen to harvest coho salmon. The department relaxed restrictions after over 90 percent of the king and chum salmon

runs were no longer susceptible to harvest. An aerial survey of the Shaktoolik and Unalakleet River drainages indicated that returns of chum and pink salmon in those systems is poor and well behind historical averages.

### Port Clarence

The Pilgrim River will remain closed to subsistence net fishing. Escapement of sockeye salmon to the Pilgrim River has been weak and is not projected to meet escapement goals. The department will monitor escapement in the Pilgrim River closely.

### General Information

Obtaining subsistence fishing permits and reporting subsistence harvests can be done at the Fish and Game office in Nome during regular business hours Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m. or online at <https://www.adfg.alaska.gov/index.cfm?adfg=fishingSubsistence.main>. Harvest reports can also be returned to the drop box located near the Front Street entrance of the Nome office. Additional information can be found by calling Nome Area staff at (907) 443-5167 or from villages at (800) 560-2271.

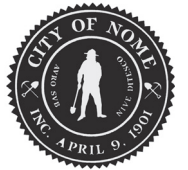
